Minutes of the meeting :-

1.	The Principal Mrs. Ketki Shendre extended a warm welcome to all Executive Committee members of PTA. Introduction of all EPTA members was taken for the smooth conduction of meeting.
2.	School quality objectives for the session 2021-22 was discussed by the Chairperson. The best practices of the school ongoing & future initiatives of the school as well as achievements of the school was briefed.
3.	Compliances of 1 st EPTA meeting conducted on 28/08/2021 was discussed. All the compliances were satisfactory and action taken by the school was appreciated by all the member
4.	Parent's feedback for the session 2020-21 Online school was explained in the percentage with the satisfactory highly praised worthy and motivating for the school.
5.	Ongoing activities and initiatives conducted in the session 2021-22 was explained and the same was appreciated by all the EPTA members.
6.	Praises were given by the EPTA members while the presentation of the achievement of session 2021-22
7.	Details of the school outstanding fees for the session 2019-20, 2020-21 & 2021-22 was presented and an appeal was made to all EPTA members to extend their contribution in collection of school outstanding fees.

	<p>The management of school has informed to the EPTA members, that as a difficulty raised due to prevailing Covid-19 Pandemic in resumption and conducting of physical classes in the school though a fees increase of 15% over the interim fees applicable for the academic year 2019-20 was approved for the academic year 2020-21 & 2021-22, but the school management has not increased the approved interim fees increase of 15% for the academic session 2020-21 and has charged the interim same fees as was charged in academic year 2019-20.</p> <p>Considering the fact that the Covid-19 pandemic has had its damaging effect on the financial condition of several formalities and to enable the parents to ensure a smooth flow of education of their wards and regular payment of fees to the school, the management has considered the request of parents sympathetically and has granted a waiver of 10% in the interim fees for the academic year 2020-21.</p> <p>Further to above, the management has allowed a waiver of 15% equal to approved increase in the interim fees for the academic year 2021-22 solely on humanitarian grounds.</p>
8.	<p>Easy fees EMI scheme was explained in details to all the present EPTA members which is the initiative taken by school to support parents to pay the school fees on time.</p>
9.	<p>Feedback was taken from the present EPTA members to each and every member appreciated the conduction of online school, initiatives taken by the school. Also agreed to support the upcoming events. They also agreed that school outstanding fees amount is huge. So, they will be taking initiatives to support school for recovery purpose.</p>
10.	<p>School management has proposed the increase in school fees by 15% over the fees applicable for the academic year 2021-22</p> <p>The above proposal has been considered by the Executive Parents Teachers Association (hereinafter referred to as “EPTA”), keeping in mind the various factors mentioned in section 9 of the Maharashtra Educational Institutions (Regulation of Fees) Act, 2011 (hereinafter referred to as a “Said Act”) and on finding the aforesaid proposal to be reasonable the EPTA has approved the increase of school fees by 15% over the fees applicable for the academic year 2021-22. The approved fees will be applicable for the academic session 2022-23 and 2023-24.</p> <p>As of now, proceedings are pending before DFRC relating to the increase of fees for the year 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22 and therefore, presently the increase is being proposed on the interim fees agreed by the EPTA during the EPTA meeting for deciding the increase in fees for the year 2020-21 and 2021-22. In case any order is passed by DFRC allowing the increase / decrease for the aforesaid year, then the proportionate quantum will be added / deducted in the fees that will be finalized / approved by the EPTA for the academic year 2022-23.</p> <p>Though the above increase of fees has been approved by the EPTA, in case of any difficulty in resumption and conducting of physical classes in the school, the school management shall consider granting waiver of 3% in fees. The said waiver is offered considering the experience relating to utilization of various facilities, services etc. during the previous period of Covid-19 pandemic.</p>
